

Infrastructure for operation of Suburban Trains in twin cities of Hyderabad and Secunderabad is in progress. The projects so identified as a result of Survey will be processed for sanction. The work will commence after the sanction to the detailed estimates of the projects are over. Begumpeth Station is part of the proposed Hyderabad Multimodal Suburban Commuter Transportation system.

(c) It is proposed to operate commuter trains on existing railway routes of Secunderabad-Falaknuma, Hyderabad/Secunderabad-Lingampalli by duly strengthening of existing Railway Infrastructure.

(d) As per the Memorandum of Understanding the requisite fixed infrastructure shall be in position within 12 months, for commencement of the project.

(h) if not, the reasons therefor?
