

- (vi) Government of India has approved the Accelerated Power Development and Reforms Programme (APDRP) which is intended for up-gradation of sub-transmission and distribution in densely electrified zones in the urban and industrial areas and improvement in commercial viability of State Electricity Boards by reducing the aggregate technical and commercial (AT&C) losses. During the year 2002-03, the Government of India has sanctioned sub-transmission and distribution (ST&D) projects amounting to Rs. 1035.80 crores for up gradation of sub-transmission and distribution in the State of Gujarat.

Wind Energy Potential

(a) the details of projects taken up to tap the wind energy potential in India since 1999-2000; and

(b) the details of projects proposed in the Tenth Five Year Plan?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF NON-CONVENTIONAL ENERGY SOURCES (SHRI M. KANNAPPAN): (a) A total wind power capacity of 1870 MW has been installed in the country. Of this, 845 MW has been installed since 1999-2000 as per the State-wise break-up given in the enclosed statement I */See* below.

(b) A wind power capacity addition of 1500 MW is envisaged during the Tenth Plan period as per the break-up given in the enclosed Statement II */See* below.

Against a target of 200 MW, a wind power capacity of 242 MW was installed during 2002-03.
