THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI SHRIPAD YESSO NAIK): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. During the last three years 93 high quality X-ray machines have been provided at the airports in India.

(c) and (d) No, Sir. However, keeping in view the poor performance of some old machines, action is in hand to replace them and upgrade the system.

Closure of Jharsuguda Airstrip

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is proposed to close down the airstrip at Jharsuguda in Orissa; if so, the reasons therefor;

(b) whether this will cause inconvenience to the passengers of Western Orissa, as this area has been surround with large private sector units; and

(c) whether it is feasible to renovate, upgrade or modernize the airstrip rather than closing it; if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI SHRIPAD YESSO NAIK): (a) and (b) The airstrip at Jharsuguda in Orissa is lying unused for want of traffic demand.

(c) As and when the Airlines indicate their plans to operate flights to and from Jharsuguda airstrip, the airstrip can be made operational by providing requisite facilities.
