THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI SUBHASH MAHARIA): (a) to (c) According to information made available by the State Governments/Union Territory Administrations, 45.81 % of the value of proposals cleared under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) in the year 2001 -02 pertained to the proposals of the Hon'ble Members of Parliament. Government have reiterated to the State Governments, through letters as well as in the Review Meetings held in September, 2002 that the project proposals ought to be prepared strictly according to the Guidelines of the Programme.
