- (a) whether Government are aware that clean water is not available to the poor living in the rural areas of Azamgarh and Mau districts of Uttar Pradesh:
- (b) whether Government have formulated any policy for the years 2002-2003 and 2003-2004 with a view to provide water to all the villages; and
  - (c) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI SUBHASH MAHARIA) (a) to (c) As per information received from Government of Uttar Pradesh, all the rural habitations in the State including those in Azamgarh and Mau districts have already

been fully covered with drinking water supply facility. However, as per the status of quality affected habitations as on 1.4.99 as received from State Government there are 4406 rural habitations in Uttar Pradesh affected with various quality problems like Fluoride, Salinity and Iron. It is proposed to cover all the rural habitations in the country with drinking water supply facility by April, 2004.

## Number of educated/uneducated/skilled/unskilled unemployed persons in the country

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI SUBHASH MAHARIA): (a) The surveys conducted by the National Sample Survey Organisation (NSSO) provided information on the incidence of unemployment by the levels of educational attainments in the rural areas of the country during the Ninth Five Year Plan.

(b) The unemployment rates (on usual status basis, as percentage to labour force) among rural people with different educational attainments for the years 1993-94 and 1999-2000 by sex for the persons of age 15 years and above are given as under:—
