Action Plan for Orissa

3076. SHRI SURENDRA LATH: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) what are the different action plans implemented for the people of KBK districts in Orissa as on date:

(b) the Central assistance provided and actual amount spent so far; and

(c) in what ways the people of those districts have benefited and developed?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PLANNING {SHRIMATI VASUNDHARA RAJE}: (a) to (c) In addition to the normal schemes being implemented by the Government of Orissa as part of their Annual Plans, the Government of India have initiated the Rashtriya Sam Vikas Yojana which, *inter-alia*, includes then Special Plan for the KBK districts of Orissa. The Special Plan for the KBK districts of Orissa for the year 2002-03 comprises of schemes relating to Drought Proofing, Livelihood Support, Support for Disadvantaged Groups, Health and Rural Connectivity for the benefit of the people of the region. A sum of Rs. 100 crore has been allocated under the Rashtriya Sam Vikas Yojana for this Special Plan. First Instalment of Special Central Assistance of Rs. 50 crore has already been released to the State Government. Further release of funds would depend on factors such as progress of schemes, submission of progress reports, etc.
