Abohar-Fazilka rail line

3249. SHRI K.M. KHAN: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether survey for laying new rail line between Abohar and Fazilka, in Punjab, has been completed; if so, when and the findings of the survey report;

(b) which route has been suggested in the survey report and what would be its total length; and

(c) by when the rail line laying work is likely to start and be completed?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI BANDARU DATTATRAYA): (a) to (c) The survey for construction of new broad gauge rail line between Abohar and Fazilka (42.717 km.) was completed in December, 1997. As per survey report, the cost of the project has been assessed as Rs. 73.15 crore with a rate of return of (-) 7.44%. The stations are proposed at Burj Mohar, Churiwala, Ghallu, Khuikhera and Jandwala. The project was included in the Budget 1997-98 with the proviso that the work would be taken up after obtaining requisite clearances, which have since been obtained in September, 2001. The final location survey has been completed and land acquisition is in process. No target date has been fixed for completion of this project.

Internet kiosks at railway stations
