

Modernisation of Kolkata Airport

*113. SHRI PRASANTA CHATTERJEE: Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government propose to modernise Kolkata Airport at par with the international airports;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) the amount of funds spent so far on the project; and

(d) the fund allocation for the said project in the Tenth Five Year Plan?

THE MINISTER OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI SYED SHAHNAWAZ HUSSAIN): (a) to (d) Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose International (NSCBI) Airport at Kolkata is one of the major International Airport of the country. Upgradation of the airport is a continuous process. The Government has also decided to restructure the four metro airports including Kolkata with private sector participation to upgrade the airport to world class standards.

The expenditure incurred on capital works during the Ninth Five Year Plan period at NSCBI Airport, Kolkata is Rs. 74.29 crores. There is a provision of Rs. 295.24 crores in the Tenth Five Year Plan for infrastructural development works at NSCBI Airport, Kolkata.
