

Production of Edible Oils

921. PROF. ALKA BALRAM KSHATRIYA: Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION be pleased to state:

(a) whether the country is producing the required quantity of edible oils;

(b) if so, the requirement, production and consumption of edible oils during the last three years, State-wise particularly in Gujarat;

(c) the quantity of edible oils imported during the said period; and

(d) the percentage of population in the country consuming indigenous edible oils, State-wise, particularly in Gujarat?
