SAI Training Centres (STC) and Centre of Excellence (COX) schemes of SAI, it is the Special Area Games (SAG) scheme which is specially focussed on talent scouting and nurturing of genetically gifted children from remote, hilly, costal and tribal areas of the country. The scheme also envisages tapping of talent from indigenous games and martial arts and from the regions which are either genetically or geographically advantageous for excellence in a particular sports discipline.
