Patents on Scientific Inventions

- (a) whether any patent has been obtained at National and International level with regard to scientific and technological inventions;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) what efforts are being made by Government to obtain help from the individuals and small organizations, for getting the patents?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY IN THE MINISTRY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY (SHRI BACHI SINGH RAWAT): (a) to (c) Patents have been obtained by Department of Science and Technology, Department of Biotechnology and CSIR in India and foreign countries. 191 patents were granted by foreign countries and 576 in India in the last three years. No help is being taken by the government from individuals and small organizations for getting patents. However, there are a number of schemes through which assistance is provided to individuals and small organizations to obtain patents. The agencies active in this aspect are Patent Facilitating Centre, National Research Development Corporation and National Innovation Foundation.
