Linking of Howrah and Sealdah Railway stations

1173. SHRI PRASANTA CHATTERJEE: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the proposal for linking the Sealdah Railway Station with Howrah Railway Station stands today;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) if not, whether the idea was cancelled; if so, when and the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI BANDARU DATTATRAYA): (a) to (c) Sealdah Station is already connected with Howrah Station *via* link line between Belanagar and East Cabin (Rajchanderapur). Two pairs of Up and Down local trains are running between Sealdah and Howrah stations.

Trains from the Opposite Directions on same Track

1174. SHRI NANA DESHMUKH: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether two trains—one the Jammu Mail and the other a goods train carrying fuel, were barely 500 metres apart when their drivers saw each other from the opposite directions on the same track and stopped in Hiranagar (Jammu), on 12th October, 2002;

(b) whether an inquiry has been instituted into the incident and the report received;

(c) if so, what are its findings; and

(d) whether installation of anti-collision devices as a train safety, which would start from next year, would be helpful in such eventualities?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI BANDARU DATTATRAYA): (a) Yes, Sir. On 12.10.2002, on Pathankot-Jammu Tawi single line section of Firozpur Division, Northern Railway, the driver of 4034 Dn Jammu Mail stopped the train between Down starter and Advanced starter signals of Ghagwal station after seeing the Up Goods train which stopped near Up Outer signal. The two trains stopped safely within a distance of more than 800 metres. The block instruments were not working and the trains were despatched on 'paper line clear'.

(b) and (c) Yes, Sir. The Committee of Officers, inquiring into the accident concluded that it occurred due to 'wrong issue of authority to proceed'.

(d) Anti-collision device is at present in trial stage.
