THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI HUKUMDEO NARAYAN YADAV): (a) DARE/ICAR has proposed Rs. 15,000 crores as X Plan outlay for agricultural research including biotechnology. In addition to this Rs. 1000 crores has been proposed as catch up grant during X Plan.

DARE/ICAR has also proposed Rs. 520 crores including Rs. 300 crores for research in agricultural biotechnology during 2002-2003. However, no separate proposal has been made for additional funds from Planning Commission for research to find gene structure in pulses and other foodgrains.

- (c) Planning Commission has communicated Rs. 4800 crores as X Plan outlay and Rs. 775 crores for the Annual Plan 2002-03.

- (b) 1. College of agriculture Imphal, Manipur Estt. in 1993, 230 B.Sc. and 69 M.Sc. candidates passed out M.Sc. (Ag.) programme in six subjects is being run.
- 2. College of Vety. Sciences & A.H. Aizawal Mizoram established on 22.10.98, newly constructed campus inaugurated on 17-10-2001. 61 candidates are on roll at Undergraduate level. 1st batch of Undergraduate level to pass out in Jan., 2003.
- 3. College of Fisheries Lembuchera Tripura Estt. on 6.11.98 and 42 candidates are entolled to Undergraduate programme & 1st batch of Undergraduates likely to pass out in Aug., 2002.

- 4. College of Horticulture, Pasighat Arunachal Pradesh Estt. in 2001 and 29 candidates have been enrolled.
 - 5. College of Home Science Tura, Meghalaya (yet to be established).
 - 6. College of Agril. Engg. Sikkim (yet to be established).
