Employment provided under SJSY in Punjab

†730. SHRIMATI GURCHARAN KAUR: Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) the district-wise details of the number of persons provided employment till date in Punjab under the Swarna Jayanti Swarozgar Yojana;

(b) whether it has been provided in the scheme that atleast one person from a family to be provided employment under the scheme, if so, the details thereof; and

(c) the steps taken to make the scheme more beneficial and effective?

THE MINISTER OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI M. VENKAIAH NAIDU): (a) The district-wise details of number of persons provided employment, since inception of the Scheme *i.e.* 1.4.1999, till date, in regard to, Punjab is at Statement (*See below*).

(b) No. Sir. As per Para 3.4 (ii) of the Swarnjayanti Gram Swarozgar Yojana (SGSY) Guidelines, all members of the Self Help Group (SHG) should belong to families below poverty line. The group shall not consist of more than one member from the same family and a person should not be a member of more than one group.

(c) The steps taken by the Ministry to make the Scheme more effective, includes the following:

- (i) Training and sensitization of the field level functionaries including Bank Officials involved in implementation of the Programme, are being organized in every State/UTs.
- (ii) The SGSY Guideline provides for involvement of NGOs/Voluntary Agencies/Community Based Organisations as facilitators, in formation, development and training of Self-Help Groups (SHGs).
- (iii) The performance of the SGSY is monitored continuously at all levels. At the Block and district levels monitoring is done through Block and District Level SGSY Committee and through annual physical verification of assets.
- (iv) The Programme is regularly monitored at the State level/Central level, on the basis of Monthly, Half-yearly and Annual Progress Reports.
- (v) The Scheme is also reviewed in the meeting of the State Level SGSY Committee in each State/ U.T.s. and at the Central Level by the Central Level Coordination Committee (CLCC) and Performance Review Committee.
- (vi) It is also monitored through visits by senior officials of the Ministry under the Area Officers Scheme.
- (vii) Issues related to credit mobilisation are discussed at regular intervals with Reserve Bank of India, NABARD and other Commercial banks.
- (viii) The Ministry also conducts concurrent evaluation and evaluation studies through reputed institutions and organisations on issues thrown up by the concurrent evaluation.
- (ix) The Swarozgaris assisted under the Scheme from State/UTs participate both in National and International Trade Fairs to promote marketing & create space for the SGSY products.
- (x) A National Conference for the State Ministers of Rural Development on the "Self-Help Group Movement in the Country and the Swarnjayanti Gram Swarozgar Yojana (SGSY)" was held in Hyderabad last year to take stock of the achievements of the SGSY since its launch and to get feed back on implementation of the Scheme from various States/U.T.s.
