However, after 25th August, 2000 the date on which Unstarred Question No. 3504 was answered no school functioning in tents have been shifted to Pucca Building. At present only following two schools are functioning from tents:

- (1) *Pragati Vihar, Lodhi Road, New Delhi.*—It is running partly in tents. Permanent school building Kendriya Vidyalaya in under construction.
- (2) No. 2 Army Bhuj, Gujarat.—It is being run tents as the
