

Financial assistance to UP under forestry development

4714. SHRI HARENDRA SINGH MALIK: Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS be pleased to state:

(a) the financial assistance provided to Uttar Pradesh for forestry development during 2000-2001 and 2001-2002, project-wise;

(b) whether the funds have been fully utilized by the State Government;

(c) if not, the reasons therefor; and

(d) the steps being taken proposed to be taken by Government in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS (SHRI T.R. BAALU): (a) to (d) Under the major centrally sponsored afforestation Schemes of Ministry of Environment and Forests, namely, Integrated Afforestation and Eco-Development Project Scheme (IAEPS including Forest Development Agency Projects), Area Oriented Fuelwood and Fodder Project Scheme (AOFFP) and Non-Timber Forest Produce Scheme (including medicinal plants) (NTFP), the financial assistance provided to Uttar Pradesh during the year 2000-2001 and 2001-2002 are as under:
