PWG Rampage on Goods Train in Andhra Pradesh

5135. SHRI C. RAMACHANDRAIAH: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether naxalites belonging People's War Group went on rampage, blasting a computerized engine of a goods train, office room of Railway Stations in the second week of February, 2002 in Andhra Pradesh;
- (b) if so, whether Government has made an assessment of loss incurred in the incidents, if so, the details thereof; and
 - (c) the steps taken to ensure that such incidents do not recur?
