Strength of NIC employees

5292. SHRI S.S. CHANDRAN: Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

(b) the sanctioned strength of the NIC employees per district unit of NIC together with the rank/status of each employees as sanctioned by Government;

(c) whether it is a fact that several employees of NIC at various district units in Tamil Nadu continue to stay for several years even after getting promotions, though their stay is violative of the rule of establishment sanctioned by Government; and

(c) if so, the action proposed to be taken in the matter?

THE MINISTER OF COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI PRAMOD MAHAJAN): (a) Sanctioned strength of National Informatics Centres (NIC) per district Unit is a District Informatics Officer in the Grade of Scientific Officer/Engineer 'SB' and a District Informatics Assistant/Associate in the grade of Scientific/ Technical Assistant.

(b) and (c) The promotion of the S&T Officials in National Informatics Centre is governed by the Flexible Complementing Scheme (FCS). This scheme provides mechanism to consider the promotion of eligible officers by upgrading their post. However the officers are required to continue to perform the same technical duties and responsibilities. A number of officials are transferred to different locations of NIC to meet the changing demand pattern in the organisation.
