(c) and (d) Some representations have been received against privatization/cooperativization of showrooms and the Hindustan Coir Factory which are under consideration of the Government.

Effect of nuclear test

†*726. DR. PRABHATHAKUR: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether nuclear test leads to dangerous effects on nature and environment;
 - (b) the likely ill effects as a result thereof; and
- (c) whether such tests can be undertaken at other places beside Rajasthan, if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF ATOMIC ENERGY (SHRIMATI VASUNDHARA RAJE): (a) Fully contained underground nuclear tests as conducted by India have no dangerous effects on nature or the environment.

- (b) does not arise in view of (a) above.
- (c) Such tests can be undertaken only at those places which fulfil certain attributes with respect to properties of rock strata, geohydrology, isolation of the place from populated area etc.
