Sale of minor girls of Afghan refugees

2701. SHRIMATI GURCHARAN KAUR: Will the Minister of **EXTERNAL AFFAIRS** be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are aware of the reports in Washington Times that 5 to 17 year old girls of Afghan refugees are being auctioned off in the frontier areas of Pakistan to serve as prostitutes or live in servitude or join herms of the rich in west Asia;

(b) if so, the details in this regard; and

(c) what steps Government propose to take at diplomatic level including SAARC to stop atrocities on women?

THE MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI JASWANT SINGH): (a) to (c) It is well known that Pakistan's self serving policies in Afghanistan for over two decades, which has also included the sponsoring and support to groups such as the Taliban and Al Qaida, have caused untold suffering to the people of Afghanistan. Women and children have been particularly affected, including by the violence over the last two decades.

Government have supported measures being taken in Afghanistan and at the international level to improve the situation of women in Afghanistan.

Discussion with Pak on security environment in South Asian sub-continent

(b) if so, what precise issues were discussed there and what was the outcome thereof?
