- (a) whether Government have felt the need to set up world class schools, to attract investment and give better education;
- (b) if so, the details of steps taken in this regard; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

Unspent funds under OBB and DPEP

- (a) whether Government are aware that funds allotted during the last three years under the Operation Black Board and District Primary Education Programme largely went unspent every year;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor and the details of unspent funds for the above programmes during the same period. State-wise; and
- (c) the fresh steps taken to increase the literacy rate of tribal women in Orissa, which is the lowest in the entire country?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT [DR. (SHRIMATI) RITA VERMA]: (a) and (b) There have been some delays in utilization of funds released for Teaching Learning Equipment (TLE) under Operation Black Board to States/UTs. Under DPEP funds are released in advance to States to meet the requirements for the next six months as per the project guidelines. However, there have been some unspent amounts also on account of the slow pace of utilization in some States. The unspent balance with States/UTs in respect of Operation Black Board and District Primary Education Programme is given in the Statement enclosed. (*See below*)

(c) As per the 55th Round of National Sample Survey 1999-2000, the female literacy rate of Scheduled Tribes in Orissa was 24 per cent as against the national average of 37 per cent in the category. With a view to tackling female illiteracy in the entire country, low female literacy districts have been identified. In such districts steps like visits by official teams to identify district specific problems, activation of Zilla Saksharata Samitis, holding of interactive sessions with the concerned State Education Secretaries etc. have been taken.
