VALLABH BHAI RAMJI BHAI KATHIRIA): (a) to (d) As per information available, the names of CPSUs with pending statutory dues, are given in the Statement alongwith the number of employees affected (*see* below). Pending statutory dues, in most of these enterprises, are generally because of resource crunch. CPSUs have been making efforts to improve their 'performance'. The Government has been assisting them with interim accommodation, rehabilitation and JV formation. In case of JV formation/closure, the Government helps liquidate all employee related liabilities.
