

**Transfer of all PSUs under one Ministry**

3005. SHRI RAJEEV SHUKLA: Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that oil sector PSUs are diversifying into other fields like IOC into power sector and GAIL into telecom;

(b) if so, what will be the relevance of having administrative Ministry as at present;

(c) whether it will not be proper to transfer all PSUs with diversified activities under the control of one Ministry; and

(d) the Government's views in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES (DR. VALLABH BHAI RAMJIBHAI KATHIRIA): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) to (d) Allocation of business to various Ministries is based on the core activities of the Ministries/Departments and the PSEs under their control. Since diversification of PSEs is supplementary to core activities, there is no proposal for any change in the present arrangement.

M/s Ernst & Young have been appointed as Global Advisor for disinvestment. Expression of interest in BWEL was invited on 11.02.2002, in response to which only one party responded.

(c) and (d) Yes, Sir, the last hearing was held in BIFR on 6.3.2002, in which BIFR was informed about the disinvestment exercise. BIFR has asked BWEL to submit an updated application.
