(b) A total of 3,68,202 telephones were disconnected by MTNL, Mumbai during the period 1st January, 2001 to 31st December, Out of this, 1,64,431 telephones were disconnected due to non-payment and 2,03,771 as per request of customer. However, during the same period, there was a net addition of 1,14,254 connections at the MTNL, Mumbai network.
