(e) if so, what steps are proposed to revive interest in this aspect of forest promotion.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS (SHRI DILIP SINGH JUDEV): (a) The Government have interacted with the Principal Chief Conservators of forests of bamboo-bearing States and requested them to submit project proposal for bamboo development in the States to ensure proper supply of bamboo to traditional bamboo users.

- (b) and (c) No requests have been received from NGOs for specific interaction with State Governments.
- (d) and (e) No, Sir. The proposals received from 16 States have been posed before Planning Commission for funding.

(c) Based on inspections reports, CPCB has directed the State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs) to take necessary action to ensure installation of required pollution control measures in the concerned industries.
