- (b) Does not arise.
- (c) Due to operational and resource constraints.

Transfer of employees

- 4462. SHRI TARINI KANTA ROY: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:
- (a) whether after the formation of East Central Railway—headquartered at Hajipur—a number of Eastern Railways employees were transferred;
- (b) if so, furnish the number of vacancies in Eastern Railway in the wake of above mentioned transfers, and
- (c) whether Government have taken any steps to fill those posts; if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI B ANDARU D ATTATRAYA): (a) Yes, Sir. 628 staff from Eastern Railway have so far been transferred to East Central Railway, Hajipur on the basis of options called from the employees.

(b) and (c) 43% Group 'C and 'D' posts from Headquarter Office of Eastern Railway are identified to be transferred to East Central Railway, Hajipur. Since all the posts to be transferred may not be vacant, for the present, only vacant posts are being transferred. This process will continue till reduction in 43% of posts in Eastern Railway Headquarter Office is achieved. Further, all the optees are now being transferred to East Central Railway, Hajipur alongwith their posts. Therefore, the question of vacancies occurring in Eastern Railway in the wake of above transfers does not arise.

Shortage of goods train

- (a) whether it is a fact thai shortage of goods trains is causing difficulty in the carriage of goods;
 - (b) if so, the steps taken by Government to solve the problem; and
