Repatriation of J&K Cadre Officers posted in other States

(c) whether there is any proposal before Government to repatriate them to their parent State; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI HARIN PATHAK): (a) 29 IAS, 12 IPS and 11 IFS officers of Jammu and Kashmir cadre are working outside the State.

(c) The Government of Jammu & Kashmir has requested for repatriation of 9 IAS and 3 IPS officers.

(d) The Government of India have approved repatriation of six IAS and two IPS officers.

(a) whether the area between the Pakistan border (LoC) and the barbed wire put up by Government is lying unutilised for cultivation;

(b) if so, the reasons therefor; and

(c) the steps taken to make the area cultivable?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI HARIN PATHAK): (a) There is no barbed wire fencing existing along the LoC.
