

Establishment grant to Universities

†*492. SHRI B.P. APTE: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) the amount of establishment grant given to various universities during the last three years, separately;

(b) the amount given to Manipur University during the same period;

(c) whether Government are considering a proposal to convert Manipur University into a Central University;

(d) whether Government are aware of the financial crisis in that University; and

(e) if so, whether any proposal is under consideration to resolve this problem?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DR. MURLI MANOHAR JOSHI): (a) UGC provides establishment (maintenance) grants to Central Universities, eligible Deemed Universities and, Delhi and BHU Colleges. A statement indicating the maintenance grants paid to these institutions during the last three years is attached (see below). Maintenance grants to State Universities, which are established by Acts of State Legislatures, are provided by the concerned State Governments.

(b) UGC provides only development grants to eligible State Universities as per the prescribed norms and subject to the availability of resources. Development grants paid by UGC to the Manipur University during the last three years are as under:—

(d) and (e) Provision of adequate development and maintenance grant to Manipur University, which has been set up by an Act of the State Legislature, is primarily the responsibility of the Government of Manipur. The Plan grants provided by the Government to UGC for disbursement to eligible State Universities have been steadily increasing over the years. As against an amount of Rs. 922.22 crore provided to UGC during the 8th Plan, an outlay of Rs. 2000.00 crore has been allocated for the 9th Plan.
