## RAJYA SABHA

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF NON-CONVENTIONAL ENERGY SOURCES (SHRI M. KANNAPPAN): (a) No, Sir. However, IOC R & D Centre at Faridabad has developed bio-diesel based on Jatropha oil by the process of trans-esterification on a pilot scale.

(b) and (c) IOC (R & D) has not done any systematic cost economic study to compute the cost of production of bio-diesel.

## Bio-Diesel Urja

4894. SHRI SUDARSHAN AKARAPU: Will the Minister of NON-CONVENTIONAL ENERGY SOURCES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether bio-diesel urja is being considered as an alternative fuel;
- (b) if so, the details of research made in this connection; and
- (c) the action taken to obtain its patent to ensure free availability in India with mass free plantation in rural wastelands?

- (b) Research and Development activities are being supported by this Ministry in the country through different R & D organizations on the development of technology for characterization of different vegetable oils, conversion of different non-edible oils to bio-diesel, effect of these bio-fuels on the conventional engines, optimum level of bio-fuel blends to be used, etc.
- (c) Efforts are being made for growing non-edible seed oil plants such as Jatropha Curcas, Karanja etc. on wastelands in the country. The Ministry of Rural Development which is responsible for wasteland development is working in this area.
