Export of handloom items to foreign countries

†2923. SHRI ABHAY KANT PRASAD: Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

(a) the details of the countries to which handloom items were exported during the last three years, year-wise till date;

(b) whether Government have formulated any special scheme keeping in view the rising demand of Indian handloom items in the foreign countries; and

(c) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF TEXTILES (SHRI BASANGOUDA R. PATIL): (a) The details of the top 25 countries to which handloom items were exported during the last three years (1999-2000 to 2001-02) are annexed as Statement (*See* below). The export data for the

year 2002-03 is available only upto November 2002 and for the subsequent period, the same is not yet made available by the concerned agency.

(b) and (c) Yes, Sir. In order to give impetus to the export of handloom products, a scheme namely "Development of Exportable Products and their Marketing (DEPM)* had been in operation since 1996-97 till the end of the Ninth Plan. The scheme continues to be implemented during the Tenth Five Year Plan with minor modifications and under a modified nomenclature of "Handloom Export Scheme". The Handloom Export Scheme envisages provision of financial assistance to the handloom agencies such as National and State Level Handloom Corporations, Apex Cooperative Societies, Primary Handloom Weavers' Cooperative Societies and Private Handloom Exporters recommended by Handloom Export Promotion Council, for development of export worthy handloom products, publicity and international marketing thereof and setting up of value addition/quality control units. Financial assistance is also provided under the scheme to Handloom Export Promotion Council (HEPC), Association of Corporations and Apex Societies of Handlooms (ACASH) etc. for organising participation of their members in international fairs/ exhibitions/Buyer-Seller-Meets.
