Price of Medopar

5151. SHRI KHAN GHUFRAN ZAHIDI: Will the Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that recently Government have increased the price of medicine 'Medopar' by more than 68 per cent;

(b) if so, what are the details of import prices and why such a steep price increase is allowed by NPPA; and

(c) whether this medicine is available indigenously, if so, the price thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS (SHRI CHHATRAPAL SINGH): (a) to (c) Madopar, used in the treatment of Parkison's disease, is combination of Scheduled bulk drug, namely, Levodopa with non-Scheduled bulk drug Benzerazide and is imported. Its import price has registered increase, which is the reason for increase in its retail price, fixed in accordance with the provisions of the Drugs (Prices Control) Order, 1995.
