THE MINISTER OF LABOUR (SHRI SAHIB SINGH VERMA): (a) Karnataka State Co-operative Apex Bank had applied for exemption under Employees Pension Scheme, 1995. Since the proposed pension scheme of the Bank was not at par with the Employees Pension Scheme, 1995, the proposal was accordingly returned to the Bank for rectification.

### **U.S. attack on Iraq**

\*405. SHRI LALIT SURI: Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

( ) whether it is a fact that United States attacked Iraq in the early hours of the 20th March, 2003;

( ) if so, Government's reaction thereto;

( ) steps taken by the Government through the aegis of the United Nations Security Council to avert war between the two countries; and

( ) the steps taken by Government to ensure minimum loss of civilian lives and property and the results thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI DIGVIJAY SINGH): (a) to (d) Coalition forces led by the USA started military action in Iraq on 20th March 2003. Government expressed its deepest anguish at the commencement of military operations in Iraq, which lacked justification and was avoidable.

Though not a member of the United Nations Security Council, India participated in all Open Meetings of the Security Council and had consistently urged peaceful resolution, within the framework of the United Nations, of the issue of Iraq's compliance with Security Council resolutions.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (MAJOR GENERAL (RETD.) B.C. KHANDURI): (a) It has been decided to improve road connectivity to 10 major ports in the country. The details are given in the enclosed Statement. All the projects are targeted for completion by December, 2005.
