Trans Asian Highway Network

- (a) whether Government had some time back visualised a major Highway Project-Trans Asian Network linking Thailand, Myanmar, India and Bangladesh;
 - (a) if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether a reference thereto was briefly made by the Prime Minister in the ASEAN meet held last year;
 - (c) whether any progress has since been made in relation thereto; and
 - (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

KHANDURI]: (a) and (b)The route connecting Indo/Pakistan Border-Delhi-Kolkata—Indo/Bangladesh Border-Dhaka-Indo/Bangladesh Border-Shillong-Imphal-Moreh has been conceptualised as a part of the Asian Highway connecting India, Bangladesh, Myanmar and Thailand among other countries of Asia.
