

**Raising of Manipur Regiment**

2167. SHRI RISHANG KEISHING: Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether the demand of raising of 'Manipur Regiment' in Indian Army Stands; and

(b) how long it will take to materialise the demand into reality?

THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI GEORGE FERNANDES): (a) and (b) There is no proposal to raise a separate Manipur Regiment in the Indian Army. The policy of the Government is not to raise any new regiment on the basis of a particular class, creed, community, religion or region, but to have an Army in which all Indians have representation.
