

- (ii) The prices of 54%, 51 % and 49% of the above medicines have gone up during the years 1999, 2000 and 2001, respectively.
- (iii) The prices of 12%, 8% and 9% of the above medicines have * declined during the same period respectively.
- (iv) The prices of 34%, 41 % and 42% of the above medicines have remained same during the same period respectively.

Profit margin for medicine manufacturers

355. SHRI RAJKUMAR DHOOT: Will the Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government have fixed profit margin for the manufacturers of medicines and drugs so that they are available at a reasonable prices;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS (SHRI CHHATTRA PAL SINGH): (a) to (c) The price fixation of the bulk drugs listed in the First Schedule to the Drugs (Prices Control) Order, 1995 (DPCO, 1995) and the formulations based thereon is done in accordance with the provisions of the DPCO, 1995. Fixation of maximum sale price of a scheduled bulk drug is done in accordance with the provisions of para 3 of the DPCO, 1995 which prescribes the rate of return for this purpose. Paras 7, 9 and 10 containing the provisions for pricing of scheduled formulations prescribe Maximum Allowable Post Manufacturing Expenses (MAPE) of return/margin.

Illegal keeping of wildlife
