## Non-electrified villages in the country

3515. SHRI AJAY MAROO : Will the Minister of POWER be pleased to state :

- (a) the present status of non-electrified villages in the country, State-wise;
- (b) the present status of rural electrification in the State of Jharkhand with reference to the total number of villages against those which have been electrified;
- (c) the target and actual number of villages electrified in the last two years (year 2001 and 2002) in Jharkhand; and
- (d) the reasons of not achieving the target?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF POWER (SHRIMATI JAYAWANTI MEHTA): (a) State-wise details of un-electrified villages in the country as on 28-2-2003 is given in the enclosed Statement (See below).

(b) According to Jharkhand State Electricity Board, there are 29,336 inhabited villages. Of these, 6418 villages are reported to be electrified after taking into account de-electrified villages as on 31-3-2003.

(c) Against the target of electrification of 1318 villages during 2001-02, 537 villages have been electrified. Again, during 2002-03, against the target of electrification of 1500 villages, 773 villages have been electrified.

(d) It has been reported by the Jharkhand State Electricity Board (JSEB) that the JSEB has come into existence only in 2001, with meager man power. Therefore, timely procurement of materials required for rural electrification work could not be done during last two years, resulting in non-achievement of targets.
