(a) whether Government are aware of the pathetic work scenario at the garment export units;

(b) if so, whether Government have conducted any survey regarding working conditions in the garment export units; and

(c) the steps taken to improve the working conditions in these units and to ensure weekly holidays, working hours and wages as per government's norms?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR (SHRI VIJAY GOEL): (a) to (c) The requisite information is being collected and will be laid on the Table of the House.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR (SHRI VIJAY GOEL): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) It is proposed to meet this expenditure from "Miscellaneous Office Expenses"—Non-recurring expenditure of EPFO.

(c) Allocation has not been made in Budget Estimate for 2003-2004. It will be made in the Revised Estimates for 2003-2004.

(d) Approximate expenditure as approved by CBT, PF is Rs. 9.47 crores.
